

Standards Conduct Dogs



First of all, we welcome you to DuermingBeds and we hope that your stay is completely satisfactory for you and your dog.

Below, we detail a series of rules of conduct regarding your dog in order to maintain harmony with the rest of the guests of our establishments.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

- Dogs may not remain in public areas of the establishment, they may only transit to access the rooms or to leave the hotel. Noble areas are understood as the entrance or reception or other common areas (except guide dogs).
- They will also not be able to access -if it were the case- the breakfast restaurant, restaurant, cafeteria or hotel lounges (except guide dogs). The terrace of the cafeteria where your dog can be (always on a leash) is excluded from this point.
- The client is responsible for any damage caused by his dog in the room or in any other area of the establishment.
- In case of any accident with another dog or with a person, the owner of the animal will be fully responsible, the accommodation being exempt from all liability for legal purposes.
- Whenever your dog circulates through common areas of the accommodation, it must be tied or in the owner's arms.
- Dogs weighing more than 15 kg are exempt from admission to the establishment.
- The accommodation reserves the right not to admit the dog, in case of showing aggressiveness or inappropriate behavior.
- Your dog should not be left alone in the room.

We wish you a satisfactory stay and remain at your disposal for any questions that may arise. We work so that in the future we can admit more types of pets in our establishments.
